FEES, PAYMENTS & REFUND POLICY

Class Fees:

- Training Level - Fourth Level, including Freestyles: \$45.00
- FEI Tests, including Freestyles: \$55.00
- Pas de Deux/Quadrille, per rider: --not offered--
- Great American Insurance/USDF Qualifying, per test, add \$10.00
- Post-entries, if space available, additional fee per test: \$10.00

Miscellaneous Fees:

- Office fee, **required** for each entry: **\$25.00**
- USEF drug & admin. fees, **required** for each horse: **\$16.00**
- USDF Non-Member Fee: \$25.00
- USDF Affidavit Fee: \$5.00

- Upper barn stabling or tack stall, per weekend: \$150.00

- Lower barn stabling E/F row: \$60.00/day or \$110.00/weekend
- Lower barn stabling 10 x 10: \$50.00/day or \$85.00/weekend
- Lower barn tack stall 10 x 10: \$40.00/day or \$75.00/weekend
- Reserved/premium parking, near lower barn stabling: \$50.00/weekend
- Reserved/premium parking, near upper barn stabling: \$100.00/weekend
- Haul-in fee (for horses not stabled on grounds) per day: --not permitted--

Non-Refundable Fees

- Change fee, for each change made after closing date: \$15.00
- Membership Verification Fee, see "ENTRIES" for detailed info: \$15.00
- Returned check/NSF fee: \$50.00
- Declined credit/debit charge fee: \$50.00

Payments

Full payment is required for the balance of the entry for an entry to be processed. DevonWood accepts checks, money orders, and credit/debit card (all major cards accepted) for entry payments made prior to show. Do **not** send cash with mailed entries. All payments must be made in US Dollar. Foreign bank notes (checks) must specify USD.

Passing a bad check is a crime. It is the competitor (or payee's) responsibility to ensure that there are sufficient funds to make payment for the total balance of the entry. ***Entries that arrive without payment will not be processed.***

Check payments should be made payable to "DevonWood Equestrian Centre." DevonWood reserves the right to convert check payments to electronic check/"EFT" payment. All check entry payments will be processed immediately at the time of receipt. *Foreign competitors:* checks must indicate payment in USD. Credit/debit card payments will be charged for the full amount listed on the entry at time of receipt.

Refunds

- **A \$30.00 cancellation fee will be deducted from all refunds.**
- Until closing date: all refundable fees returned, less \$30 cancellation fee.
- After closing date: all miscellaneous and stabling fees refunded; 50% of class fees refunded if doctor or vet note is provided and if we are able to fill your ride time.
- After February 27: No refunds.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing. Two arenas: One indoor arena (20M x 60M) and one outdoor arena (20M x 60M).

Indoor arena: (20M X 60M), with warm-up (20M X 40M), both Equi-Base footing (sand mixed with Geotek fabric over rubber matting).

An additional outdoor competition arena, 20M x 60M, with complementing warm-up, both hydro-active sand arena footing, may be used in the event that entry counts warrant an additional arena to be used. Lunging area is located near lower stabling. No lunging in warm-ups or round pens.

Awards: Ribbons awarded first through sixth place. Class 109 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-12 in ODS Omnibus for eligibility requirements.

Children & Pets. Absolutely NO DOGS ALLOWED on show grounds, except as permitted by law. Children must be supervised at all times.

Food. Concessions will be available on show grounds.

Parking. Reserved parking is available on a first come basis for a fee. Entire rig must fit within space, both length and width, to ensure clear fire lane. Electric hookups are available as a courtesy at the end of each stabling row (first come basis) and may be used between the hours of 7 pm through 7 am. Trailers and tow vehicles may park outside the main facility gates at no additional fee.

Stabling. Permanent box stalls with full doors - Upper Barn 12'x12'; Lower barns: Barn E/F has 10'x12'; Barns C/D and G/H have 10'x10'. Initial bedding provided. No bedding provided in tack stalls. Additional bedding available for purchase on site. Bedding other than shavings or pellets prohibited. *Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors.* Indicate stabling preference on entry, but realize that stalls will be assigned based on horse's size, sex, and length of stay, not just on postmark date. Stalls available Friday noon through Sunday evening. Early arrivals and late departures must be prearranged directly through DWEC.

Directions. From I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd.

Scheduling & Ride Times. Classes may be split or combined at show management's discretion. Ride times will be e-mailed at least one week prior to the show. Schedules and results will also be made available for download and viewing at the competition website, <http://bridgecity.devonwoodec.com/>
