ENTRY PROCESS

DX EVENTING

Sometimes known as a "Derby" - consists of two phases: dressage and a hybrid of show jumping and cross-country. Scored the same as a horse trial, the rider's dressage score will be *combined* with their jumping phase score.

- **DRESSAGE PHASE:** The dressage phase of the DX will take place in regulation size short court (20 meter X 40 meter arena).
- **JUMP PHASE:** The jump phase of the DX is one round which will consist of both stadium jumps in a large outdoor arena and cross-country style jumps outside of the arena, potentially in the woods and/or grazing field.

Extra Dressage/Jump Round Options:

- Competitors may choose to add another full round (judged/scored dressage and jump phase) at a discounted rate (must be same rider on same horse).
- Riders may choose to add individual rounds (not scored) of either dressage or jumping. Extra rounds added during pre-registration will be at a discounted rate. If rider would like to add additional rounds once at the competition, these will be allowed at an increased rate, and only if time permits.

PRIZES/RIBBONS

Final standings are based on *combined* scores from dressage and jumping round. Prizes to 1st and ribbons to 6th in each division. Classes may be divided. Results will be posted on Startbox.

STABLING

All horses must be stalled while at DevonWood. **A stall is required for every entry.** Trailer tying is not permitted unless tacking up. Horse may never be left unattended when tied to trailer. Horses are **NOT** permitted outside the facility fence line. If you choose to tack up in your trailer, your trailer must be parked within the fence line.

- **BEDDING:** Bedding is **NOT** included. You may bring in own bedding - straw not permitted. Shavings bales are available for purchase onsite at \$10 per bale.
- **TACK STALLS:** Tack stalls are available for \$15 per day. You may also use your trailer for a tack room. Tacking up at your trailer is permitted as long as horse is not left unattended at any time.
- **SAFETY:** Cross country vests and medical armbands **REQUIRED** for any cross country jumping or schooling.

Stall Cleaning Rebate: To be eligible for a stall rebate, the assigned stall must be fully stripped down to the original surface. Once the stall has been cleared, the competitor is required to return the stall card to the show office. A cash stall rebate of \$15 will be given on site.

Refunds: Before closing date, refund less \$25.00 non-refundable office fee; After closing date, refunds only with vet or doctor's letter, less \$25.00 non-refundable office fee. After noon October 9th - No Refund. If competition is cancelled – refunds will be returned after expenses paid, money divided among competitors.
